A bin's lid colour now identifies its function, whatever the bin itself's colour.
 Even if empty, completely-green garden bins need to be left out on Wednesday 27th to have their lids replaced.

20th May to 16th June: the effects of changeover occur in Snape
Wed 20th May: last grey-bin collection before Tuesday 16th June
 * Wednesday 27th May: final collection under the old timetable
 Tuesday 2nd June: first collection under the new timetable
 typical timetable pattern, once everything has settled down

Food caddies cleared weekly; any food, can be in daily plastic bags

Garden bins continue to be cleared fortnightly.

Paper and card will be going to the paper mill, so must be clean.

Recycling can now include unbroken glass bottles & jars, aerosols, EMPTY plastic bags, clingfilm, tetrapack (e.g. milk/juice) cartons.
